3. What is something daring you'd like to do for God now? What fears stand in the way of you doing

4. What do you think God would like to say to you about those fears?
5. As you're pursuing a God-sized vision, where does your Wild Goose chase go from here?

WHAT WILL YOU DO?

1. Recognize the areas of you life that are controlled by fear. (Money, time, love, failure, talent) What is one step that you can will take to to begin living out of God's mission.
2. How can you start living out the L2 life in your own life? How can you start living this out at home, work, vacation, and all other areas of your life.
3. What is one area of "impossibility" you need to trust God in, and take action on?
