Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature.*

4. Make 6-7 different observations about these verses? In other words, what are these verses saying to you?

5. Behavior follows thinking ("*do not think about...*"). What kinds of thoughts lead to improper sexual behavior?

6. What does it mean to clothe yourself with the Lord Jesus Christ?

7. From a practical point of view, how do you keep from gratifying the desires of the sinful nature?

What are three things you will do to apply Romans 13:13-14 to your life, singleness or marriage?

How might God play a role in your romance?

What does your love life need?

What aspects of your sexual life will you surrender to God as an act of worship?
