Explain this statement. How do you do this?

7. What are some ways you can honor God with your body?

WHAT WILL YOU DO?

If you are single, where or when are you the most vulnerable? How can you honor God (and your future spouse) with purity today? What safeguards do you need to put into place?

If you are married, in what ways can you better honor your spouse? (Be specific and follow through!)

What are you doing to divorce-proof your marriage?

What sexual sins do you need to come clean with God on? (Agree with God about your sins and thank Him for His forgiveness.)
