THE BEST OF SOLOMON

What do you want? Ask, and I will give it to you! 1 Kings 3:5 (NLT)

Give me an understanding heart so that I can govern your people well and know the difference between right and wrong. 1 Kings 3:9 (NLT)

DISCOVERING THE DIVINE PATH

Command 1: *Trust in the LORD with all your heart...* Proverbs 3:5 (TNIV)

Command 2: *lean not on your own understanding...* Proverbs 3:5 (TNIV)

Command 3: *in all your ways submit to him...* Proverbs 3:6 (TNIV)

Submission precedes direction.

Promise: *and he will make your paths straight.* Proverbs 3:6 (TNIV)

Command: *Do not be wise in your own eyes...* Proverbs 3:7 (TNIV)

THE WORST OF SOLOMON

As Solomon grew old, his wives turned his heart after other gods, and his heart was not fully devoted to the LORD his God, as the heart of David his father had been. 1 Kings 11:4 (TNIV)
