**1. DO NOT BE JUDGE AND JURY**

*"Do not judge..."* Matthew 7:1 (TNIV)

*"Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."* Matthew 7:1-2 (TNIV)

**2. LOOK AT YOUR OWN FAULTS FIRST**

*"Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in someone else's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?"* Matthew 7:3 (TNIV)

*"How can you say, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?"* Matthew 7:4 (TNIV)

**3. LIMIT YOUR ADVICE TO "DO AS I DO"**

*"You hypocrite..."* Matthew 7:5a (TNIV)

**Step 1: Look in the mirror**

*"...first take the plank out of your own eye..."* Matthew 7:5b (TNIV)

**Step 2: Delicately remove their fault**

*"...and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from the other person's eye."* Matthew 7:5c (TNIV)
